Most children will be tutored after school, so now GNC will start later - after tutoring. Four came for the first club. Chardon Hills GNC had a delayed start because of snow, but the following week 14 enthusiastic children came. Maple Intermediate School in North Olmsted plans to start in the spring.

More *GNC* Teams are needed to broaden the impact of these clubs. Doors are wide open at Family First Childcare Center for a team to come in regularly to lead *GNC*s. Hi, I'm Bradley Castle, but I like to be called BJ. I grew up in Columbus, Ohio and attended Columbus First Free Will Baptist Church with my family twice a week.
