# Ire and Ayonimi Brother-sister team for Greater Cleveland 5 Day Clubs

Ire and Ayonimi have successfully completed the Christian Youth in Action® (CYIA™) training held for Ohio Summer Missionaries at Cedarville University. It was Ire's second year, so he

trained to be a Senior Missionary Assistant (SMA), with increased teaching responsibilities. Ayonimi will serve as a Junior Missionary.

The training is active and all participate. Students present their teaching to small groups for practice and evaluation. The group plays the role of children, responding to directions and questions. Ayonimi felt these practicums were the most helpful. The weather was very hot! Ayonimi said, "It was a little too hot for sports, so we were in our dorms during our free time. Having chill time rather than being active all the time was good."

Ire was also glad he went to CYIA this year as an SMA student. Their training focused on teaching Missions and the memory verses. "It was a good experience. We got to learn and understand the missionary story and what we were doing this for. The 1-Day Club we held really gave us an idea of where we were at." This 1-Day Club was held at the end of the training week so the students experience working with real children.

Of our eight 5-Day Clubs, four are at new locations. As I write this letter, only one club has taken place. Leela, the hostess, is new to CEF. She came to an Easter training because a friend brought her. In looking for opportunities to reach children with the Gospel, the 5-Day Club proved doable. Good News Club® teachers came to help with the teaching. Ire and Ayonimi joined the team to share in the teaching and joy.

Of the four children registered, one was there every day, and she put her trust in Jesus the very first day. God also used this club to establish connection with more neighbors. One neighbor heard the children singing and opened her window to ask, "Are you Christians?"

The July 18-22 club could inspire a church to recruit their own youth to serve next year. The August 8-12 club could spark a new awareness of a church that cares about its community. God has supplied for each club.

There were other venues we couldn't visit this year for lack of available workers. God is opening doors in answer to your prayers. Let's plead with Him for more workers next year. Wouldn't it be great to have two complete teams to serve at 14 club locations? (Luke 10:2)
