Our Mission Statement: CEF is a Bible-centered, worldwide organization composed of born-again believers whose purpose is to evangelize boys and girls with the Gospel of the Lord Jesus Christ, to disciple them in the Word of God and to establish them in a local church for Christian living.

ur Mission Statement defines who we are. Church Partnership describes how we seek to serve the local church. What then is the path to church partnership?

The starting point is prayer. God is the One who opens doors for partnership and brings like-minded believers together to proclaim the Gospel to the children who need to hear and believe.

Step two involves pastoral visits to discern the needs of the church and their vision for outreach to children who have yet to hear the Gospel Message. As each pastor learns more about *CEF*, they see how we might come alongside them to encourage and strengthen their children's workers.

The next step includes action points, to meet the more pressing and felt needs of a church's Children's Ministries. This then affords opportunity to reinforce their vision for outreach and offer ministry opportunities and training for concerted ministry to unchurched children.

Two churches in Euclid have recently started on this path to partnership.

New Life Christian Church International (New Life) was looking for a Children's Church curriculum and Gospel training for



their people. In March, Martha presented the various aspects of the *CEF Good News Club* curriculum to their teachers, pastors, and deacons. This curriculum fit their need. Then Martha met with Hope, a teen with a passion for children and a desire to serve as a summer missionary.

In April, twenty-seven volunteers came to the Wordless Book training at New Life to learn to explain the Gospel to children. They want to use this training to share the Gospel at Euclid's *200th Street Stroll*, the Saturday after Memorial Day.

Pastor Malone is working towards equipping the people of **Providence Baptist Church** to expand their outreach to unchurched children.

Eula Tucker and Sharon Tufts are Providence members who know *CEF* well and will serve as Martha's liaisons to plan and coordinate meetings, trainings, and Lord willing, summer 5-Day Clubs. Ask God to raise up volunteers to serve as summer missionaries and host families for this concerted outreach to bring the Gospel to even more children.



Prayer and Praise

- Praise God for four active after-school Good News Clubs, reaching 100 children with the Gospel.
- Praise God that 12 children trusted in Jesus last month. Pray that they grow in their new-found faith.
- **Praise God for** the start of two new Church Partnerships in Euclid and for 34 volunteers trained in sharing the Wordless Book in April.
- **Pray** that friends trained at Providence Baptist and New Life Christian Church International will use what they learned to evangelize even more children this summer.
- Pray for teens and adults to apply for our Christian Youth in Action training in June. Ire, Ayonimi and Hope want to
 be summer missionaries. Ask God to guide us and to raise up even more summer missionaries so we could double the
 number of children reached this summer.
